President's Message.



This is my first contribution to the newsletter as BHSP President. I join the new directors -- **David Mason, Todd Boyd, and Brian Swain** – and Vice-President **Darlene Ormond** in acknowledging the work of retiring officers and directors -- **Ruth Dorkin, Gerald Morris, Becky Tuten, Gary Hollis, William Asa Waters, and Dale**

Benson -- and the foundation they provide for beginning our work.

I expect you will read exciting news about developments with BHSP in reports from the Building and Fundraising Committee Chairs. The respective tasks are delegated by the board to these committees which have unique abilities, interests and information about their work. They can certainly tell their story better than I.

The role of the board and officers is to coordinate the actions of the committees and provide resources and support for them to get their jobs done. For the past year, the focus of that coordination has been the auditorium project.

With two of the three wings having been reused to serve as a library and exhibit hall, we have focused efforts on the remaining wing to be reused as an auditorium and multiple use meeting space. For the past year we have seen potential for this process to be greatly advanced by a grant from the State of North Carolina for that purpose. A grant has been included in some form in both the budget proposal from the governor and in the budget appropriation bill passed by the legislature. We believe the administration and legislators have been convinced of the merit of our project, but --like all other appropriations in that bill -- authorization is subject to the

political process. We recently learned that the NC Senate adjourned without enacting the budget appropriation bill of which the auditorium grant was a part. Whether it is a part of a future budget or some other less comprehensive legislation, we remain optimistic about this grant.

As examples of the coordination provided by the board:

- **Our grants committee has engaged legislators and provided guidance to our directors and other supporters for doing so as well.**
- **Our building committee has adjusted priorities to provide plans and budgets to support our case and to hold on expenditures that might satisfy requirements for matching funds for the State of NC grant or any other grant with that condition.**
- **The Finance and Bylaws committees are adjusting procedures to ensure we are in compliance with the terms and conditions of any major grant.**
- **We anticipate a significant need for Fundraising and donations to satisfy match requirements if the appropriation ultimately becomes law.**
- **We also coordinate efforts and welcome resolutions of support from cooperating entities such as the Historic Bath Foundation, Town of Bath, and Beaufort County government.**

This is a project that obviously requires widely varied skills and interests from a diverse group of volunteers and cooperators. It also requires coordination of those efforts. None of this would have happened or will happen without dues, donations and patronage from our members and supporters. We thank all those involved for getting us where we are and for the potential to complete the project.
